Catheter ablation Catheter ablation is a procedure that very carefully destroys the diseased area of your heart and interrupts abnormal electrical circuits. It's an option if medicine has not been effective or tolerated. Catheters (thin, soft wires) are guided through one of your veins into your heart, where they record electrical activity.

Atrial fibrillation happens when electrical impulses fire off from different places in the top chambers of the heart (the atria) in a disorganised way. These irregular impulses cause the atria to quiver or twitch, which is known as fibrillation. This causes an irregular, and sometimes fast, heartbeat or pulse.
