(Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations (3 CCR) *. For pesticide handlers, the pesticide safety training program must meet the requirements set forth in 3 CCR section 6724 *. When pesticides are used for research or commercial production of an agricultural plant commodity, a qualified trainer must provide the training.

You must be at least 18 years old. Before you perform handler tasks on an agricultural establishment, you should receive training and access to site-specific information about the recent pesticide application (s). When mixing and loading pesticides, your employer should provide materials for routine washing and emergency decontamination. When handling pesticides with labels requiring eye protection, you must have immediate access to at least one pint of water at all times.

National Worker Protection Standard: A Manual for Trainers. According to the revised Worker Protection Standard, starting on January 2, 2017, farm workers and pesticide handlers must receive training before they begin work and every 12 months. That training includes information about pesticide residue, the potential health effects of pesticide exposure, and how to avoid bringing pesticide risks home.

National Worker Protection Standard: A Manual for Trainers

This manual is a required study guide for the Private Applicator Certification examination. All California farm owners, managers, and employees involved with the use of pesticides should have it. It covers pesticide labels, mixing and applying pesticides, hazards of pesticide use, and pesticide emergencies.

Commercial pesticide handlers and their employees are included in the WPS even if some of the pesticide handling tasks (mixing, loading, disposing, etc.) take place somewhere other than the agricultural establishment that is the treatment site. Handling opened containers of pesticides. Acting as a flagger. Cleaning, handling, adjusting, or repairing the parts of mixing, loading, or application equipment that may contain pesticide residues. Assisting with the application of pesticides, including incorporating the pesticide into the soil after the application has occurred.
