Forty years later, the eastern bluebird was formally adopted as the state bird through the signing of New York State Consolidated Laws Article 6 ...

Short-eared owls are listed as endangered in New York and the other states where small populations remain. Grassland birds depend on large, open expanses of grassland to successfully breed, forage and raise their young. Most of these species nest on the ground.

New to bird identification? If so, here are a few things that you should know. A few species, like the Northern Cardinal, do not migrate. They stay in the same area on a year-round basis. Most birds migrate, sometimes long distances and sometimes a short distance. In some species some birds migrate and others do not.

The last state to officially designate a state bird, New York was relatively informal in selecting the eastern bluebird as its representative. The bird was sponsored by a simple referendum of the New York State Federation of Women's Clubs in 1928, but it would take more than 40 years to make the selection official.

Bewick's Wren: Small wren with unstreaked, gray to red-brown upperparts and plain white underparts. White eyebrows are conspicuous. Tail is long and white-edged with dark bars. Bill is long and slightly decurved. Legs and feet are gray. Eastern populations are red-brown, Northwestern birds are more brown, and Western Interior birds are gray-brown.

New York, the aggressive forerunner in so many ways, was the last state in the Union to acquire an official state bird, and it was not until May 18, 1970, that Governor Rockefeller signed a bill elevating the eastern bluebird (*Sialia sialis*) to a select group of twenty-nine species representing the forty-nine states.
